ALL SPECTATORS ENTER AT THEIR OWN RISK

Masks

- Masks are strongly recommended when social distancing cannot be followed.
- Masks will not be provided. Spectators should plan to bring their own mask.

Gate

- Social Distancing is strongly encouraged.
- More than one gate line may be established for varsity games in order to limit the line length and crowding.

Hand Sanitizer

Hand Sanitizer stations will be set up on near the entrance and exits for spectator use.

Concession Stand

- Concessions will be for sale.
- Concession customers are strongly encouraged to social distance and wear masks when in line.
- Concession workers will wear plastic gloves and masks. •
- Concessions may be discontinued without prior notice.

Spectator Seating / Standing & Attendance

- Spectators are strongly recommended to wear masks and physically distance as much as • possible while in attendance at all events
- Elementary and middle school students will be expected to sit in family groups or in a designated student area.
- At any time we may limit the number of spectators who may attend an event. •

Restrooms

- Regular restroom facilities will be available for spectators. If a larger crowd is expected, • more portable restrooms may be available in order to limit crowding.
- ٠ Spectators should make every reasonable effort to wear masks and physically distance while waiting to use the restroom.
- Restrooms will be cleaned periodically during the event. ٠

Signage

- Signage will be placed throughout the facility to remind spectators to wear masks and social distance.
- Regular announcements may be made reminding spectators to respect the rights of others by social distancing and wearing a mask.

Attendance at Away Contests

- DC West families are expected to adhere to the visiting school's COVID- 19 policies and procedures.
- DC West Families should plan to take a mask to all visiting venues as they may be required to wear them.
- Concessions may or may not be offered at all facilities. ٠

Event Protocols – Participants

Masks

- Participants and coaches will wear masks on school transportation to and from the event.
- Coaches will wear masks when unable to social distance. ٠
- Players will wear masks when appropriate during competition.

Locker Rooms

- Participants and coaches will wear masks when unable to social distance.
- Locker rooms may not be available. Participants are encouraged to change before leaving DC West.

Temperature Checks

Participants may be temperature checked when entering the locker room for home events and before boarding school transportation on away trips.

Teams

- Teams are expected to stay with each other and not intermingle with other teams. •
- Participants are expected to have their own water bottles and not share them with peers. •
- At the conclusion of competition, handshaking will not be permitted.
- Douglas County West participants and coaches are expected to adhere to the visiting • school's COVID- 19 policies and procedures.
